REAL ID...Did you know?

Did you know a REAL ID will be required to travel on commercial aircraft beginning in October of 2020? You can visit a driver's license station anytime to obtain a REAL ID, or opt to upgrade to a REAL ID when renewing your driver's license in Iowa between now and October of 2020. It's important to note you will need to bring certain documents to meet identity requirements. Your REAL ID will have a gold star in the upper, right-hand corner of the card (shown in photo above).
